AMENDED ORDER GRANTING ATTORNEY'S FEES AND COSTS

ORDER FOR JUDGMENT AND JUDGMENT

Defendants.

The above-entitled matter came on before the undersigned Judge of District Court Judge on the 15th day of July, 2004, at the Sherburne County Government Center, Elk River, Minnesota.

APPEARANCES WERE AS FOLLOWS:

Plaintiff appeared pro se. James A. Bumgardner, Attorney at Law, appeared for and on behalf of the Defendants.

At that hearing, the Court granted Defendants' Motion for Summary Judgment on the grounds of collateral estoppel and res judicata and invited Defendants to submit an affidavit for attorney's fees and costs. On July 26, 2004, Mr. Bumgardner's affidavit was received. Based upon that affidavit, and all the files, records and proceedings herein the court hereby makes the following:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Plaintiff's lawsuit is without merit, brought in bad faith, and barred by the doctrines of collateral estoppel and res judicata.
- 2. Defendants' answer timely raised these defenses.
- 3. Plaintiff's lawsuit is brought to harass. Plaintiff is subject to MN Civ.P.Rule 11 sanctions.
- 4. Plaintiff was warned by Judge Galler, on June 25, 2004, that costs and attorney's fees could be awarded against him.
- 5. Defendants have been forced to expend costs and attorney's fees in defending against this, the second of Plaintiff's actions.
- 6. The costs and fees sought by Defendants are reasonable and are commensurate with fees customarily charged in the community.

ORDER

- 1. Defendants' Motion for Summary Judgment is **GRANTED**. Plaintiff's lawsuit is dismissed, with prejudice.
- 2. Plaintiff's Motion for Summary Judgment is **DENIED**.
- 3. Defendants are hereby awarded costs and attorney's fees totaling \$16,694.87 against Plaintiff.
- 4. Plaintiff is barred, restrained, and enjoined from commencing any lawsuit against any of the herein Defendants without first having the proposed lawsuit reviewed by the Chief Judge and obtaining OWNINGERSOTA COUNTY OF SHERBURNE Permission to commence suit.
